BICYCLE LANE REQUEST SURVEY

Bike Lanes

A portion of a roadway which has been designated by striping, signing, and pavement markings for the preferential or exclusive use of bicyclists.

Purpose of bicycle Lanes:

- 1. Create on street travel facilities for cyclists;
- 2. Provide additional separation between pedestrians and motor vehicles; and
- 3. Adding on street lanes reduces the effective crossing distance for pedestrians.

Estimated Cost:

The cost of installing a bike – lane is approximately \$15,000 per mile, depending on the condition of the pavement, the extent of removing and repainting of lane lines, and other factors. The best time to create bicycle lanes is during regular street reconstruction, street resurfacing or at the time of original construction.

Clarification:

The request and decision to establish bike lanes should be made with the knowledge that bike lanes are not the solution to all bicycle related problems. They are not a substitution for sidewalks. Many of the problems are related to improper road user behavior and can only be corrected through effective education and enforcement programs.
